Abstract:

The abstract must be typed and single space. It must be prepared as follows: (1) Title; (2) Author(s); (3) Institution affiliation(s); and (4) Text. The text must be 150 words or less and must describe the purpose, methods, and materials that will be used. It should be clearly and concisely written as it may be published in the program for the meeting.

Required Materials:

1. Three letters of recommendation.
2. Complete lesson plan.
3. Evidence of use of the lesson in the classroom (this may include, but is not limited to, assessments, student work, videos, etc.)

Presentation:

Winners of a CRAM scholarship award are required to present their lessons during the NCGE meeting in order to receive the scholarship. These workshop sessions are scheduled to last 45-minutes. Please indicate above any equipment that you require in order to present your lesson.
